1. Download the SDMG letter and take it to your Society's board for approval ASAP. Some boards need time before their meetings to consider a motion. We need to hear from you by 9:00 AM, Monday, March 19, 2018.
2. Upon approval, email editor@sdmg.org with your club contact info below or your personal info, if you are signing on as an individual to SDMG's letter. Be sure to include one sentence asking to add your club/or yourself to the letter.

*Signature info as a
gem-mineral society
or other organization* Officer name and title (usually club president)
Club/org/school name
Number of members in your club
Club mailing address (mandatory minimum info is city, state, zip code)

*Signature info as a
an individual* Your name
Committee/officer role/title (optional, if you want to show your affiliation)
Club/org/school name (optional, if you want to show your affiliation)
Address (city and state required – you may want to omit home street
address – all information will be made public online by BLM)
